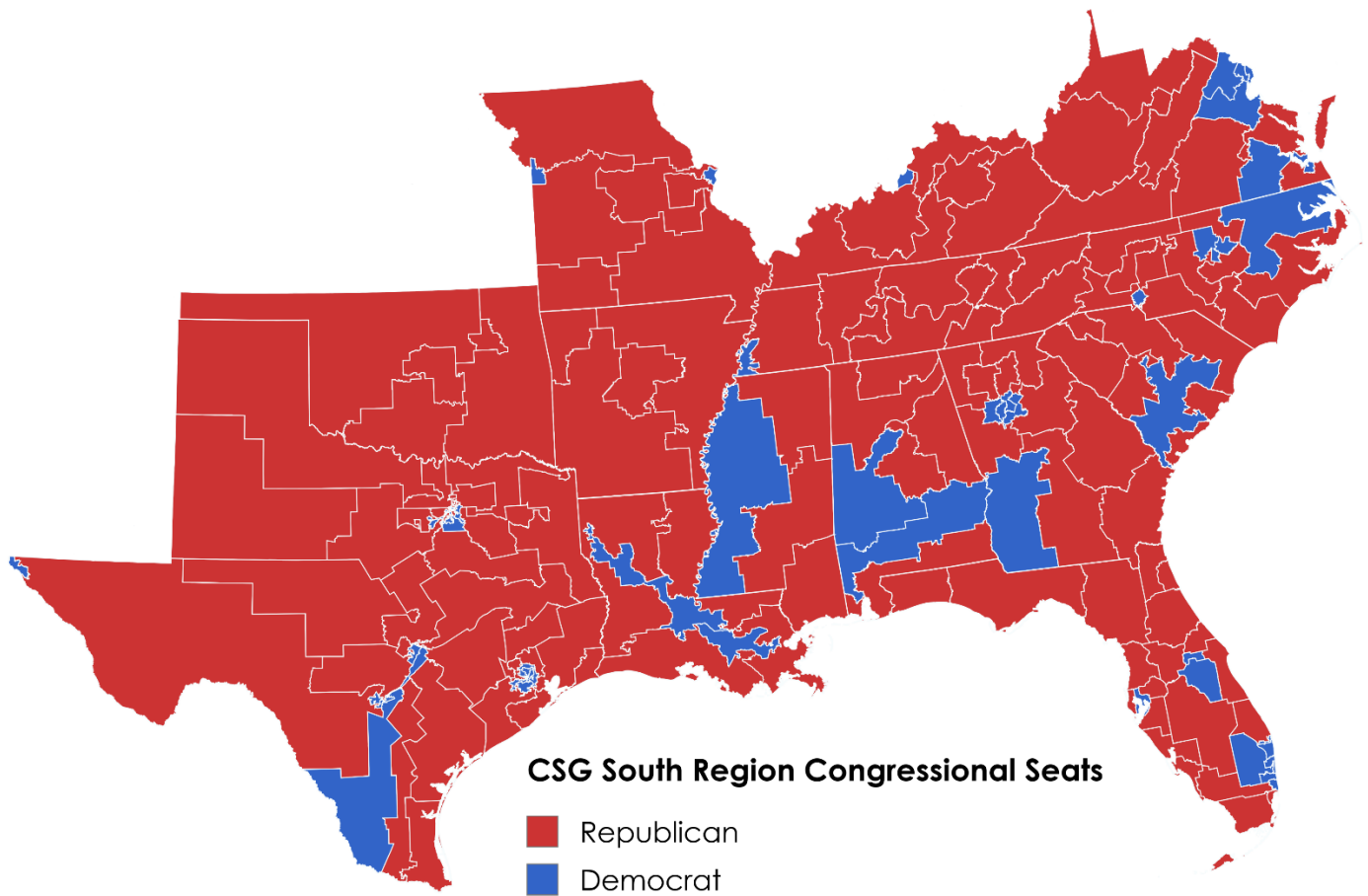




Southern State Congressional Districts

Executive Summary

For the 119th Congress, Republicans hold a five-seat lead with 217 Republican members to 212 Democrats, along with one Independent Representative and five current vacancies due to resignations or deaths.¹ The CSG South region has a total of 163 Congresspeople – 118 Republicans and 45 Democrats – representing more than 37 percent of the entire U.S. House of Representatives. On a partisan basis, more than 72 percent of the region’s delegation is Republican and nearly 28 percent is Democratic. From 2020 to 2024, based on the presidential election results for each Congressional District, the CSG South region as a whole shifted by 5 percentage points towards the Republican Party. Notably, due to current and recently proposed and enacted redistricting efforts in 10 states – including Alabama, Florida, Louisiana, Missouri, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia in the South. These figures are expected to significantly change after the November 2026 General Elections.
